PROJECT SUMMARY:

Aaniiih Nakoda College (ANC) is a tribally controlled community college located on the Fort Belknap Indian Reservation in north central Montana. The project offers training programs in five distinct areas, including: (1) Allied Health, (2) Computer Information Systems, (3) Integrated Environmental Science, (4) Building Trades and (5) Business Technology.

PROJECT OBJECTIVES:

- To provide classroom instruction, academic support, work related experiences, academic and career counseling, placement services and direct student assistance to at least 45 full-time students each year over the period of the grant.
- To assist at least 85% of project participants to successfully complete their training programs.
- To assist at least 75% of participants to find employment in their related training field.
