The Alamo Navajo School Board, Inc. (ANSBI) operates under resolutions from the Alamo Navajo Community and from the Navajo Tribe. The overall goal of the Alamo Navajo Career and Technical Education Project is to implement coherent and rigorous CTE services for targeted secondary (11th/12th grade), postsecondary, and adult learners, enabling them to become productive students and employees meet the needs of a global workforce.

PROJECT OBJECTIVES:

- To prepare 100% of the NACTEP-CTE enrolled secondary (11th/12th grade) students with CTE skill proficiencies as demonstrated by completion of dual credit courses that will lead to attainment of an industry-recognized credential, certificate, and/or AA degree over the grant period.
- To assist 100% of the NACTEP-CTE enrolled postsecondary students to attain CTE skill proficiencies aligned with industry-recognized standards, gain or retain employment, continue or complete their postsecondary education, or be placed in military or apprenticeship programs over the grant period.
- To assist the NACTEP-CTE enrolled adult learners in attaining CTE skill proficiencies to gain or retain employment, upgrade job skills, enroll in postsecondary training program, complete courses toward and obtain an industry recognized certificate, and/or placement in military or apprenticeship programs.
