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PROJECT SUMMARY:

The Blackfeet Manpower One-Stop Center proposes an exemplary approach that involves coordination with Blackfeet Tribal Economic Development Plan, Blackfeet Community College, Blackfeet Tribal Employment Rights Office (TERO) employment and training services. Blackfeet Manpower One-Stop Center will assure that students will be provided with technical skill competency assessments, industrial certifications and job placements. The NACTEP will provide career and technical training within the clusters of Tourism/Entrepreneurship occupations and apprenticeship occupations.

PROJECT OBJECTIVES:

- Provide two-year associate degree programs.
- Provide 30 credit hours of study for 15 students annually.
- Provide 30 credit hours of study for 15 students in Hospitality annually
- Serve 35 Apprentices in the Apprenticeship Occupations Program.
- Administer necessary duties and responsibilities to assure program requirements and objectives are met.
- Provide counseling and follow-up services to all NACTEP Students.
- Support a minimum of 30 students each semester with job shadowing opportunities.
