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PROJECT SUMMARY:

The College of Menominee Nation (CMN) is a tribally controlled community college with campuses in Keshena and Green Bay, Wisconsin. The college plans to continue its technical education one-year diploma programs in Welding, Electricity, and Office Technician. The Computer Numerical Control (CNC) Machinist program has been developed and approved to run a full course schedule in spring 2017. There will be development of two one year technical diploma programs, Computer Support Specialist and Wood Manufacturing Technology, projected to run fall 2017. Short term workshops in the one year technical diploma areas will continue to be offered at both campuses. The Technical Education department also offers a Medical Terminology workshop, Home Health Aide course and a Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) program.

PROJECT OBJECTIVES:

- To infuse and pilot technology in 100% of the existing technical education programs by September 2016.
- To develop and pilot one STEM-focused technical diploma and modify one STEM focused Associate Degree program into a technical diploma by September 2016.
- To expand the existing Technical Education services by September 2016.
