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**PROJECT SUMMARY:**

The Hoopa Career and Technical Education Program will provide services to students on the Hoopa Valley Indian Reservation and surrounding areas. The project will strengthen and expand its partnerships with multiple California Colleges. The program will increase employment and entrepreneurship in private and Tribal enterprises, as well as in natural resources/forestry technology, small business management, childcare and early childhood education, and other existing and emerging professions and occupations.

**PROJECT OBJECTIVES:**

- At least 50 students will participate in certificate and degree programs that will prepare them for these employment opportunities; 60-70% will complete certificates and degrees timely; and 80% of those graduates will realize employment gains or transfer to four-year.
- The Hoopa Career and Technical Education Program will select, support, and provide quality services that consists of: individual assessments, career pathways, financial support, academic advising, and employment or transfer services upon completion of training
