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PROJECT SUMMARY:

Turtle Mountain Community College (TMCC) is a tribally controlled post-secondary institution. The project is designed to offer postsecondary career and technical education opportunities in Management with emphasis in Accounting and Project Management; Computer Support Specialist with an emphasis in Networking and Computer Maintenance and Building Construction Technology with emphasis in Green Building Technology and Renovation. The Native American Career and Technical Education grant will provide career and technical education opportunities to 80 individuals during the course of the project.

To provide career and technical education to 80 individuals during the course of the project, in four program areas that respond to the needs identified in the Turtle Mountain Tribe's economic plan and identified needs of the local labor market;

PROGRAM OBJECTIVES:

- During the duration of the grant, the Building Construction Technology program will provide training to 30 students with 75% receiving certificates of completion; 75% receiving industry certification and 80% being placed in employment, additional education or military.
- During the duration of the grant, the Computer Support Specialist program will provide training to 20 students with 75% receiving certificates of completion; 75% receiving industry certification and 80% being placed in employment, additional education or military.

- During the duration of the grant, the Management program, to include Entrepreneurial and Business Administration will provide training to 30 students with 75% receiving certificates of completion; 75% receiving industry certification and 80% being placed in employment, additional education or military.
