Kapi`olani Community College's Kulia ma Kapi`olani Project consists of a highly refined and effective suite of culturally-based support services woven into various Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs.

A significant emphasis is placed on internship opportunities within all CTE programs, especially the health sciences. The project has a high rate of employment placement for students successfully completing their particular program of study.

PROJECT OBJECTIVES:

- To provide a safe and welcoming community environment for 75 Native Hawaiian students where learning, career development, and relationships can be fostered and is conducive to the successful progress, retention, and graduation.
- To provide academic support via the project's peer counselors/mentors/tutors as well as other on campus resources such as Kahikoluamea and the STEM Center.
- To complete a career plan for each participant to include resume preparation and editing; mock interviews with evaluations, critiques and recommendation for improvement; membership in professional organizations to build networks and relationships; additional training outside of campus curriculum via conferences and workshops; professional licensure and certification as determined by the field of employment.
- To provide stipends to students in internships to defray the time and cost of the unpaid internship.
