Appears easier for secondary programs to report 1STP1 (25 reporting) than other secondary indicators, while 1STP3 seems the most difficult (17-18 reporting)

All secondary indicators increased over time except 1STP3 which dropped about 6 percentage points

The largest secondary increase was 1STP5 which increased about 17 percentage points

Appears easier for postsecondary programs to report 1PTP1 & 3 than other postsecondary indicators. No indicators increased over time. 1PTP2 largest decline

Interesting observations may include: [1STP1 TO 1PTP3&4], [1STP2 TO 1PTP1], [1STP3 TO 1PTP2], [1STP4 TO 1PTP1&2], [1STP5 TO 1PTP3]

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
