## WORLD PREMIERE OF ANDREW SLATER'S DOCUMENTARY ECHO IN THE CANYON TO OPEN THE LA FILM FESTIVAL

# PREMIERES SECTION, FUTURE FILMMAKERS SHOWCASE & INDIE PILOTS ANNOUNCED

LOS ANGELES (August 15, 2018) — Today the LA Film Festival, produced by Film Independent, the nonprofit arts organization that also produces the Film Independent Spirit Awards, announced that the Opening Night Film is Andrew Slater's *Echo in the Canyon* at the Ford Theatres. The World Premiere of the documentary, which features some of music's biggest names reflecting on the sustained influence of Laurel Canyon's historic music scene, will be followed by a live performance. Also announced today the Premieres section, the Future Filmmakers Showcase, the Music Video program and the Indie Pilot program.

"I'm so proud to be opening the Festival with a love song to Los Angeles via Andrew Slater's *Echo in the Canyon*," said Jennifer Cochis, Festival Director. "We are committed to showcasing documentaries, and premiering this work at the Ford Theatres to be followed by a live musical performance is going to be a once in a lifetime experience."
