STAFF & LEADER TRAINING

All Renaissance Kids Staff and Leaders have undergone a four-step application process including the following: an initial contact interview, a background check, an application with spiritual application and reference check, and a four-week preliminary training period. Furthermore, a Leader must volunteer for six months before applying to be on the Ren Kids Staff. After applying, he or she undergoes an additional four-consecutive-week preliminary period during which he or she is trained to follow state childcare safety regulations and all Ren Kids emergency procedures. Once an official member of the Staff, he or she begins attending weekly meetings to keep up with spiritual, educational, and safety training. Our Ren Kids Team is constantly working to make our program the best it can be for your children. We believe that our system ensures the maintenance of necessary professional safety while also creating opportunities for middle-school-aged, high-school-aged, and parent volunteers.

ALLERGIES AND ILLNESSES

If your child has any food allergies, please make sure that you alert us during check-in. Once entered into the system, their allergy will appear on their tag, informing all present and future Staff and Leaders of their condition. For the protection of all the children in our program, if your child has any signs of cold or illness, we ask that you refrain from bringing them into the classrooms.

SPECIAL NEEDS

It is our desire to serve each and every child that comes through our doors. If your child has any special physical or mental challenges and will need individual assistance in order to participate fully, please contact us so that we can make every effort to ensure his or her experience is a positive one. We do our best to accommodate at every service; however, if you want your child to make the most of our program, we recommend attending our 11:00 Sunday service. At this time, one of our small groups is lead by a teacher certified in special education and currently training to be an applied behavioral analyst.

FAMILY IDENTIFICATION & PAGER SYSTEM

To ensure the safety of our children, each child will receive a name tag with a security identification number that matches a parent identification number. The parent or guardian must show this to the teacher upon pick-up or they will be unable to pick up the child without the parent's and Director's approval. In addition to this system, each parent will also receive a pager. If your child is not adjusting or if there is an emergency of any kind, we will page you back to registration.
