CONNECT

DISCUSS

The Garden of Eden Magnified (*Revelation 22:1–5*)

In the vision given to John, the end looks like the beginning in Eden only magnified. Creation's curse is lifted, the garden is restored, and the tree of life is always in season.

- Where do you see the greatest need for healing in our world?
- Where do you feel the greatest need for healing in your life?

The End of Conflict (*Micah 4:3–4*)

- Which of the world's conflicts would you most like to see come to an end? Why?
- Describe a personal conflict that would require miraculous intervention to be healed.

The End of Loss (*Joel 2:25*)

- Where have you lost something good that you wish you could get back?
- What would it look like to receive divine repayment?

The End of Illness (*Isaiah 35:5–7*)

- How have you struggled due to illness?
- Describe your dream scenario of physical renewal in God's new creation.

The End of Sorrow (*Jeremiah 31:10–14*)

- Name the three greatest causes of sorrow for you.
- What would it look like for each to be transformed into joy?

Ask God to give you patience where you have to wait for the healing he promises in the end.
Ask for wisdom and courage to be his agent of healing in the meantime.
