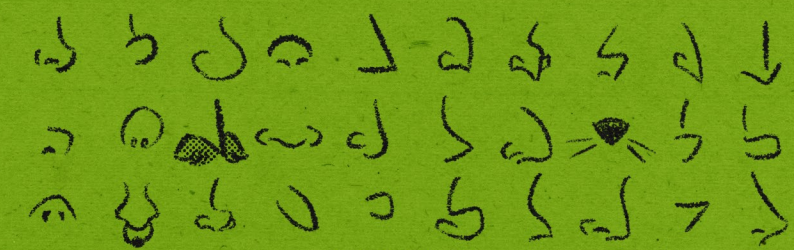

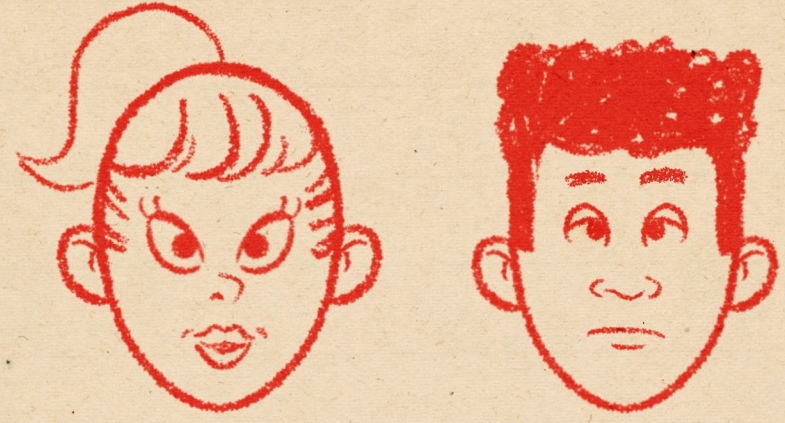


Drawing different faces can be a fun and easy way to sharpen your drawing skills.

DRAWING *different* FACES



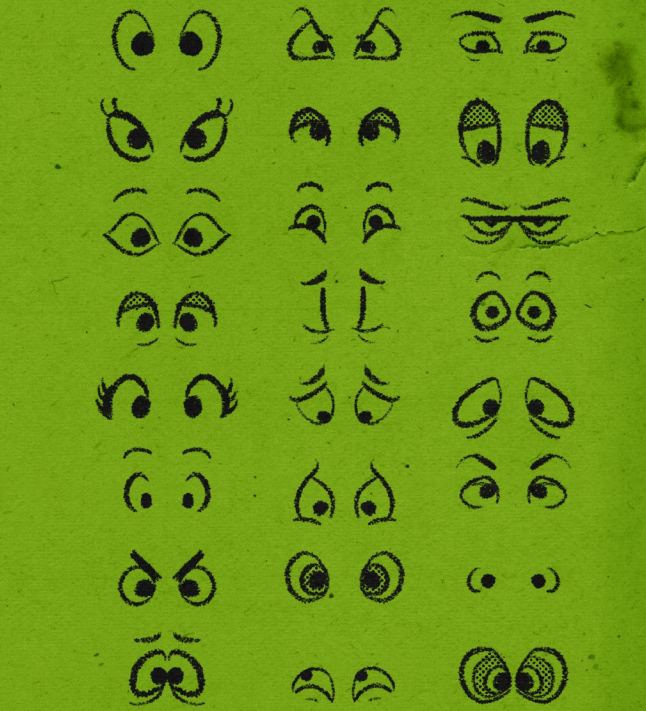
Now lightly draw some guidelines to help you find the middle of your face. One line goes up and down. One line goes side to side. This will help you keep balance as you add in facial features.

Find some eyes, a mouth and a nose from the examples we have shown and draw them onto your character's face.

Now add your character's hair. Did you notice that every feature you try adds a different personality? Try making up your own!
