 - i. II Co 4:4 "In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of **the glorious gospel of Christ**, who is the image of God, should shine unto them." (KJV) (emphasis mine)
- 3. The gospel is the "good news" which explains the glory of Christ.
 - a. This is seen, in no better way, than by Paul in his letter to the Romans.
 - i. **Ro 1:16** "For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek." (NKJV)

III. Outcome Of The Gospel

- A. It is "unto salvation"
 - 1. Ro 1:16; Mt 1:21; Lk 19:10; Jn 1:29

IV. Outreach Of The Gospel

- A. It is "for everyone who believes"
 - 1. Ro 1:16; Ti 2:11; I Jn 2:2; II Co 9:15

V. Order Of The Gospel

- A. It is "for the Jew first and also for the Greek"
 - 1. Ro 1:16; Ac 1:8
