

*AN Ordinance, which shall be known and may be cited as the "Liberty Preservation Ordinance."
To prevent federal infringement on due process; prohibiting participation in all federal acts which
purport to authorize indefinite detention.*

SECTION 1: The _____ County Board of Commissioners finds that:

A. The President of the United States has asserted that the Authorization for the Use of Military Force (Public Law 107-40), enacted in 2001, authorizes the President to indefinitely detain, without charge, any person within the borders of the United States.

B. Language in Sections 1021 and 1022 of the National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA) for fiscal year 2012 purports to permit indefinite detention without public trial of persons captured on US soil.

C. As signed into law October 1, 2013 by Governor Jerry Brown as the California Liberty Preservation Act, the official policy of the State of California is "to refuse to provide material support for or to participate in any way with the implementation within this state of any federal law that purports to authorize indefinite detention of a person within California."

D. It is the stated policy of the governing body of the (COUNTY CITY TOWN) of _____ to implement this new state policy regarding indefinite detention within the (COUNTY CITY TOWN) of _____.

SECTION 2: PROHIBITION ON PARTICIPATION IN ACTIVITIES WHICH AID FEDERAL
DETENTION WITHOUT DUE PROCESS

A. No agent, employee, or official of the (COUNTY CITY TOWN) of _____, or any corporation providing services to the (COUNTY CITY TOWN) of _____ shall provide material support for, or participate in any with the implementation of any federal acts, orders, rules, laws or regulations which purport to authorize the indefinite detention of a person within this (COUNTY CITY TOWN).

SECTION 3. REQUESTED INVOLVEMENT OF NEIGHBORING COMMUNITIES
