AN ACT to prohibit the Commissioner of Insurance from enforcing or investigating any health care insurance related provision of the federal Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act of 2010, Public Law 111-148.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF (STATE)

**SECTION 1. Prohibition on Actions by the Commissioner of Insurance.**

(CODE NUMBER)

The Commissioner of Insurance is prohibited from enforcing or investigating any healthcare insurance related provision of the federal Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act of 2010, Public Law 111-148. Nothing in this Code section shall be construed to apply to the regulation of rates or rate filings, investigations, administrative or judicial proceedings, or any other duty or responsibility arising under state or local law regarding health care insurers by the Commissioner of Insurance.

**SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE**

This act takes effect upon approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law without such approval.
