

This bill clarifies the implementation of certain provisions of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act of 2010, Public Law 111-148. This bill prohibits the state of (STATE) from planning, creating, or participating in a state health care exchange.

AN ACT relative to federal health care reform and health care exchanges.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF (STATE)

SECTION 1. Prohibition on State-Based Health Exchange.

A. No (STATE) state agency, department, or political subdivision of this state shall plan, create, participate in or enable a state-based exchange for health insurance under the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act of 2012, Public Law 111-148, or contract with any private entity to do so on behalf of this state or a political subdivision of this state.

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE

This act takes effect upon approval by the Governor.
