Mark 16

Jesus had died on the cross and was buried in a tomb. On the first day of the week, Mary Magdalene, Mary the mother of James, and Salome went to the tomb. It was very early in the morning on the third day after Jesus' death. The women brought spices with them so they could anoint Jesus' body.

As they walked to the tomb, they thought about the large stone covering the entrance to the tomb. "Who will roll away the stone for us?" they wondered. But as they got close to the tomb, they saw that the stone was already rolled away.

The women went into the tomb. A young man wearing a white robe was sitting inside. He was an angel, and the women were afraid.

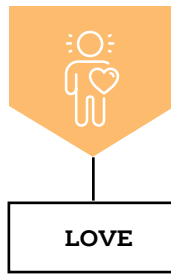

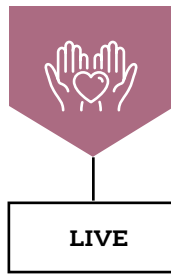
» Is there any obstacle in your life keeping you from following Jesus as you should?
