I. Introduction

This Third Amendment to the KCI Corridor Tax Increment Financing Plan (the "Third Amendment") shall amend the KCI Corridor Redevelopment Plan as approved by the Ordinance No. 990256 (referred to herein as the "Plan") and subsequently amended by the Ordinance No. _______ (referred to herein as the "First Amendment") and Ordinance No. _______ (referred to herein as the "Second Amendment"). The Third Amendment, if approved, would provide for the revision of Exhibit 6, the Estimated Redevelopment Project Costs to provide for additional road improvements. The specified road improvements are essential to the preparation of the Redevelopment Area for use in accordance with the KCI Corridor TIF Plan. To the extent the Plan varies with the Third Amendment, said Plan shall be amended and superseded thereby.

II. Specific Amendments

The KCI Corridor TIF Plan shall be amended as follows:

Amendment No. 1: Delete Section I.C. of the Plan in its entirety, and insert the following in lieu thereof.

Project Improvements. The Project Improvements to be financed under this Plan will consist of the construction of a half diamond interchange at MO 152 and Ambassador Drive, Ambassador Drive from Tiffany Springs Parkway, Tiffany Springs/I-29 Parkway Interchange, Tiffany Springs Road over I-29, Skyview Avenue from Ambassador Drive to Tiffany Springs Parkway, Green Hills Road from MoDOT improvements at MO 152 north to Tiffany Springs Parkway, Tiffany Springs Road From Green Hills Road to Skyview and 500 feet east and west of Congress, Tiffany Springs Parkway from existing east end to Green Hills Road, Congress between MO 152 and Prairie View Road, and extraordinary costs related to Barry Road and N. Boardwalk Drive related to the improvements listed herein. These specified road improvements are essential to the preparation of the Redevelopment Area for use in accordance with the KCI Corridor TIF Plan. It is anticipated that the incremental revenue will result from the construction of retail and office commercial development with the Redevelopment Area.

Amendment No. 2: Delete the first sentence of Section IV.A. of the Plan in its entirety, and insert the following in lieu thereof.

Redevelopment Project Costs are estimated to be approximately \$90,144,163 of which \$84,344,163 will qualify as Reimbursable Project Costs.

Amendment No. 3: Delete Exhibit 6, Estimated Redevelopment Project Costs, in its entirety, and insert the revised Exhibit 6 as attached hereto.

AMENDMENT No. 4: Delete Exhibit 7A, Source of Funds, in its entirety, and insert the revised Exhibit 7 as attached hereto.
