The Bear Creek Lake Park Time Trial is back! The course is just over eight miles of undulating terrain, weaving its way through the scenic Bear Creek Lake Park. The start will be at Pelican Point and the parking will be at Big Soda Lake. Riders should allow ample time to ride from the parking area to the start. The road will be open to traffic so you must stay on the right side of the road! The center line rule will be in effect; crossing the center line is grounds for disqualification.

Location: Bear Creek Lake Park, 15600 W. Morrison Rd. Located just off C-470 & Morrison road exit. Parking will be in the park and signs will lead you to the parking area. The start of the race will be at Pelican Point.

Start Times: The first USAC/BRAC rider will start at 4:00pm. The first collegiate team will start at 5:30pm. Categories will run in the following order:

Women's P/1/2... 4:00pm	Men's 4/5	Collegiate C Women... 5:30pm
Women's 3	Men's 35+ (followed immediately by 10 min break)	Collegiate B Women
Women's 4	JM/JW 13-14	Collegiate A Women

Men's P/1/2	JM/JW 17-18	Collegiate B Men
Men's 3		Collegiate A Men

Registration for Collegiate athletes will open at 3:00 pm and close at 5:00 pm. USAC/BRAC racers must preregister online at www.prerace.com. No day of race registration. The start list for pre-registered riders will be posted at the start on Saturday, as well as online (www.rmccc.org and www.prerace.com) Friday night. Pick up race numbers and sign waivers at least 40 min prior to start time. Registration will take place at the parking lot at Pelican Point. Riders are encouraged to ride from the parking area to registration, as there will be ongoing races.

Collegiate Races: \$20. Must have a valid USAC Collegiate license. Collegiate racers may also enter the USAC/BRAC races for \$10 second event fee.

USAC/BRAC races: \$30. Must have a valid USAC road license. 1-day USAC license (\$10) available for cat 5 men, cat 4 women and juniors. BRAC annual membership recommended to avoid an additional \$5 fee for a 1-Day BRAC membership. Juniors races \$20. Entry fee includes \$3/day USAC insurance surcharge and \$2.50/day USAC LA surcharge.

Annual USAC licenses and BRAC memberships will not be sold at race site. USAC annuals are available at www.usacycling.com

BRAC memberships are available at www.coloradocycling.org

Gear restrictions apply to all juniors 10-18; see USAC Rule 1M6 s/b 1I4. Bike restrictions apply to all juniors 14 and under; see USAC Rule 1M7 s/b 1I5.

New USAC TT Rule: Riders may choose to enter single-day individual time trials in their proper category or any higher category, but not lower category.
