Collegiate Dual Conference Weekend & Sunday USAC Criterium

Saturday directions and parking: All staging will be in Olsburg, KS at Olsburg Elementary. From Manhattan, take Highway 24 North then take a right onto KS-13 North. Continue on KS-13 N for 14 miles and turn left onto KS-16 West. Continue for 5 miles to Olsburg.

Time trial course will be a 12 mile out and back going West of Olsburg. Two minute gaps between teams. Course is open to traffic.

We will offer onsite registration for USAC races on Sunday for \$30. Registration opens at 11am and closes 30 minutes before the start of each race.

Collegiate Entry Fees are \$15 per athlete per race and \$10 per time trial team. Prizes will be food, merchandise and bragging rights. Collegiate athletes are encouraged to enter USAC races for \$5 discounts.

Non-collegiate athletes can register online at usacycling.org for \$25 until April 4. Day of registration is \$30. There is a discount of \$5 off two or more races.

Rules: All USAC rules apply. CPSC approved helmets required at all times. Promoter reserves the right to adjust start times and distances, alter or change courses, remove riders from a race, cancel categories and prize lists as deemed necessary on the day of the race. Riders under 18 must have rider release signed by parent or legal guardian. All riders must present a valid and current USA Cycling license in order to compete. Onsite one day licenses are \$10.
