The 2013 Ohio Spring Race Series (OSRS) wraps up with a Stage Race Finale. This is a true stage race in which you must complete each stage in order to start the next. You will be registering for the entire weekend of racing, not each individual stage. Take advantage of this rare opportunity to participate in a Stage Race for amateur cyclists.

**REGISTRATION:** Online registration is available at BikeReg.com. Online registration will close at 11:45 PM on Thursday, May 16, 2013. Pre-registration is highly encouraged. A \$20 late fee will be assessed to all day of event registrations except juniors. Onsite registration and check in will be at the **Taylor High School Student Parking lot** on Miami Rd and will be open 7:30 AM until 9:00 AM on Saturday, May 18, 2013. The school's address is 36 East Harrison Ave, North Bend, OH 45052. All riders will also be required to sign in at the start line for each stage. Please line up early to avoid delaying the start of the events.

**RULES AND REGULATIONS:** All USA Cycling rules and regulations must be followed and will be enforced. All riders must have a current USA Cycling racing license or a one-day license. One-day licenses will be available at check in and can only be used by Cat 5 Men, Cat 4 Women and Juniors. The promoter reserves the right to combine categories based upon number of riders. The \$3 charge for USA Cycling Insurance and any online registration fees are covered by the above entry fees. Please refer to section [3H.] in the 2013 USA Cycling Rulebook for Stage Race rules.

**RESULTS:** All results will be submitted to USA Cycling within 48 hours after the official results are final.

**SERIES RULES:** This event is part of the Ohio Spring Race Series. The best 5 finishes in the series will count towards the overall series' standings. This event gives you the opportunity to earn points 4 times, one for each stage and one for the Overall General Classification (GC).

**TIMING AND TIME BONUSES:** The entire weekend will be electronically timed. The timing will be primarily used to calculate the overall GC for the Stage Race. Per USA Cycling rules [3H4(c)], time bonuses will be offered in the two road races ONLY. We will offer time bonuses for the top 3 riders at the finish (10" – 6" – 4"), half-stage (6" – 4" – 2"), and intermediate sprints (3" – 2" – 1"). Considering the normal course distances used in the OSRS, we will offer the time bonuses each time the race crosses the start/finish and pre-determine which lap will be for the half-stage sprint. **The time bonuses will ONLY count towards the Overall GC and NOT the final results of each stage.**

### SATURDAY, MAY 18, 2013

#### Stage 1: North Bend Time Trial

This will be a short 3.8-mile, non-aero time trial to establish rider times for the rest of the Stage Race. **No aero equipment will be permitted in this event** to level the playing field. Only mass-start bicycles will be permitted. Riders will not be permitted to use disc wheels, aerobars or aero-helmets for this event. The start will be near the entrance of the power plant by the water fountain. The finish will be by the gravel lot across from Harrison's Tomb. This will also be the finish line for the road race later in the day. Starting times will be posted on BigDaveSports.com by 8PM on Friday, May 17, 2013. **Riders will start at 9:30 AM** and be staggered based on the number of participants to stay on schedule.

#### Stage 2: Harrison's Tomb Road Race

The course starts with a short climb to the top of the world where you'll be treated with an incredible view over the Ohio River. It continues climbing on a more moderate grade before sending you down a long and winding downhill. You'll then spend the next 7.5 miles on a rolling road that follows the Great Miami and Ohio Rivers back to the start/finish line. **Riders must be at staging 15 minutes prior to their start to sign in BEFORE the stage start.**

#### Stage 3: Germantown Road Race

Parking will be at the Germantown Metropark Cottonwood Shelter at 6910 Boomershine Road, Germantown, Ohio 45327. **Riders must be at staging 15 minutes prior to their start to sign in BEFORE the stage start.**
