

Hell's Kitchen Road Race

Sunday March 17, 2013 - Hogeys, Arkansas

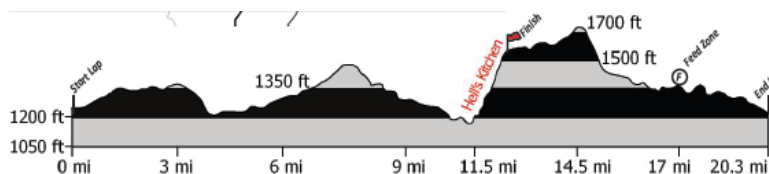
Held under USA Cycling Permit (Pending)

Race Details:

The race consists of a 20 mile loop with rolling hills and the "Hell's Kitchen" climb. The course will have four left hand turns and will be clearly marked by course marshals. There will be traffic on the course so take caution in these turns. Staging area will be at the Hogeys church and adjoining field. Feed zone will be marked and is located a half mile after the top of Hell's Kitchen climb. For the second consecutive year the finish line will be at the top of the Hell's Kitchen climb on Washington County Rd 215.

Course Details:

Neutral roll out from the Hogeys church to the gas station. This starts the counter-clockwise race loop traveling on Washington County (WC) Rd 28 for 4 miles. At this point there is a very fast downhill left-hand turn onto WC21. This road includes a .5 mile climb. As the pavement comes to an end on WC21, turn left onto WC215 for 2 miles. This road includes the "Hell's Kitchen" climb (where the race will finish). Riders will then take one more left turn onto hwy 265 towards Hogeys for the remaining 6.6 miles to complete the race loop.



Directions and Race Info:

- > From Fayetteville on I-540 take Cato Springs Rd exit 60 and travel south towards Hogeys for 9.5 miles. Parking will be clearly marked at the Hogeys church which will be the staging area for the race.
- > For online race registration go to www.bikereg.com/Net/18104 (online registration closed 3/14)
- > Race day registration will be available on site until 9:30 am
- > Men Category 5 fields are limited to 50 riders. If more than 50 Category 5 riders register, then two groups will be established and separated by age: 34 and under, 35 and over.
- > Master Men - All riders are competing for the overall purse. 50+ racers are eligible for the 40+ purse. 50+ purse is bonus money. Ex. if a 50+ rider finishes first overall, then they receive both the overall first place cash, plus first place 50+ bonus money.
- > USA Cycling license is required for this event. One day USAC licenses (\$10) and annual licenses will be available for purchase.
- > **FIRST RACE STARTS AT 10:00 AM. All other fields will be going off in 6 minute intervals after that (in order of payout schedule below).**
