The Criteriums held at Firehill are part of the 4 race per month Central Oklahoma Race Series. The CORS will feature 2 Crits at Firehill, 1 Time Trial at Lake Overholser, and 1 Circuit Race at Lake Draper. The series is a points accruing based event and the race payout is based on the racers overall point accumulation during the series events. Points will be awarded on the following scale: 1<sup>st</sup>= 11pts 2<sup>nd</sup>= 10pts 3<sup>rd</sup>= 9pts 4<sup>th</sup>= 8pts 5<sup>th</sup>= 7pts 6<sup>th</sup>= 6pts 7<sup>th</sup>= 5pts 8<sup>th</sup>= 4pts 9<sup>th</sup>= 3pts 10<sup>th</sup>= 2pts Field Finish= 1pt.

### **Race Categories:**

The following races will be scored for CORS points and for USAC graded points (based on USAC rules). Races will be grouped for time restraints/available daylight, but results will be scored separately for points and payout.

A's- Cat 1,2,3 Men

B's- Experienced Cat 5's, Cat 4 Men, Women 1,2,3, Masters 50+ Masters 60+ Men

C's- Beginner/First Time Cat 5 Men, Cat 4 W, Jrs. 10-14 Mixed, Jrs. 14-18 Mixed

Races will be a minimum of 30 minutes, optimum 45-50 minutes depending on available sunlight. Category B and C races will run concurrently on the same course but will begin in separate groups and scored separately.

**Course Information:**

Edmond Fire Training Center (*Firehill*). It is a variously hilly course with many twists and turns which allows for many course setups. We will feature uphill finishes, flat sprint finishes, and total flat course setups. Course variations will be held at promoter’s discretion, arrive early to pre-ride.

**Registration**

Online Registration through USA Cycling for the Monthly Series will be available for a special rate of \$60, or \$15 per event. Race day registration will be available at 5:00P, races start at 6:00P. You will not be able to pay for the special series rate after the first event in the monthly series. After the first race, the per race event charge will be \$18 per event in the series. **Prizes: Series Payouts:** Payouts will be awarded at the first race after the series completion. Must participate in 3 of 4 events for series consideration.
