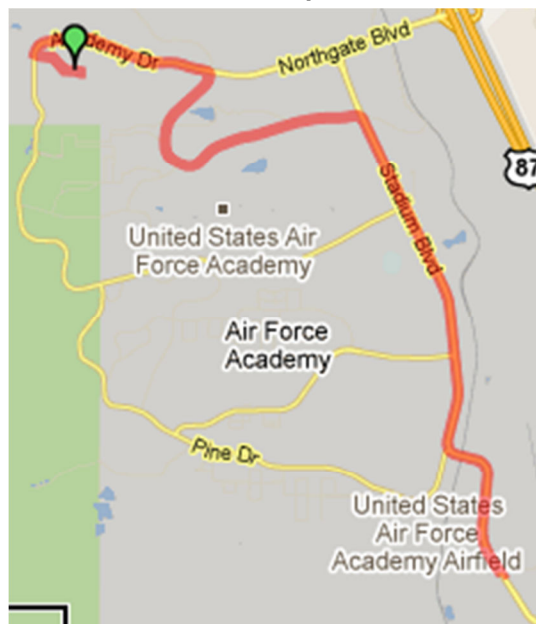
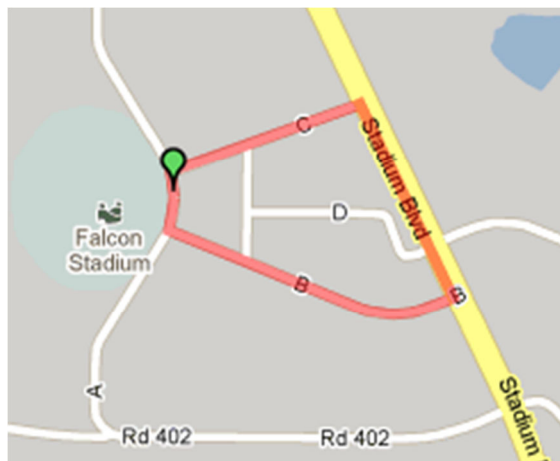


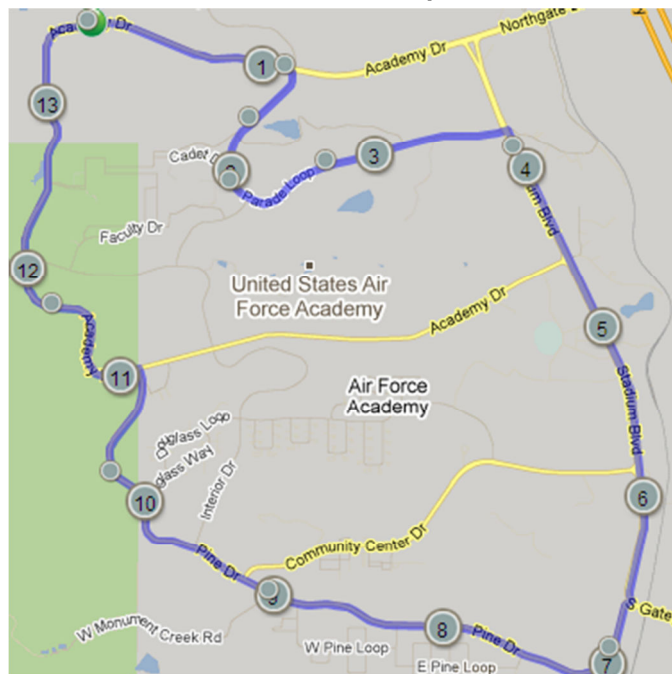
TT Map

Cautions:

- Course open to traffic; during race, you are in rolling enclosure; off the back obey rules of the road.
- High winds are common at USAFA; deep dish wheels at your own risk
- **Crossing the centerline results in DQ**

Feed Zone: On uphill by finish. No neutral feeds.

Support: No team vehicles allowed.

Directions:

Falcon Stadium - Exit 156b off I-25 (North Gate); enter Academy (must show state issued ID); turn south onto Stadium Blvd (at the B-52); right on Academy Dr (just before football stadium); first left then follow road to race parking on left at stadium.

Athletic Fields - Exit 156b off I-25 (North Gate); enter Academy (must show state issued ID); continue west on North Gate Blvd (pass overlooks and road curves to left); parking on left (by athletic fields)

Arnold Hall - Exit 156b off I-25 (North Gate); enter Academy (must show state issued ID); continue west on North Gate Blvd (pass overlooks and road curves to left); continue passed athletic fields; left on Cadet Dr; parking on left

Permitted under USAC.
