A UCI P1 International Para-cycling Event

The Greenville SC Para-cycling Open is the first UCI event to be held in the United States since 2009. The event, which is also part of the 2013 U.S. Handcycling Series, will be utilized by the U.S. Paralympic Cycling Team to select athletes for international competitions in 2013 and 2014. For the first time ever at an American event, the UCI will offer international classification for athletes who have not yet been classified, or need to be re-evaluated.

Who can Participate

While the 2014 World Championships in Greenville will be a **nations event**, the 2013 Greenville Para-cycling Open is an event open to any Para-cyclist, from any country. Athletes from at more than ten nations are expected to participate, including numerous Paralympic and World Champions.

The Site

The 2013 event includes an individual time trial and road race for all Para-cyclists, and will be conducted at the Millennium Campus, adjacent to the Clemson University Center for Automotive Research in Greenville. This will be the same site that will host the **2014 UCI Para-cycling World Championships**, and is a great opportunity for any athlete to test their skills on the World Championship race courses.

Time Trial

The Time Trial course is 7 kilometers per lap, and will be held on Saturday, April 20. The course – which was previously utilized for the USA Cycling Professional Championships, starting and finishing at the opposite end – is undulating and moderately technical. Cyclists who have ridden the course describe it as a “fair course” that will likely favor an all around rider who excels in a variety of terrain.

Road Race

The Road Race course is 11.5 kilometers per lap, and will be held on Sunday, April 21. The course utilizes the same roads as the time trial, with an extra 4.5 kilometer section that will likely shed riders without strong endurance and climbing skills.



7.0 km/4.4 miles




Course Maps and Profiles

Licensing and Membership Information

The 2013 Greenville SC Para-cycling Open is a UCI event. All athletes who participate (and finish their respective competitions) will earn UCI points (see <http://www.uci.ch> for more information). All participants must hold an international cycling license issued by their National Federation. **No exceptions.** For American athletes, this license can be obtained from USA Cycling: <http://www.usacycling.org>

Note: *An annual domestic license from USA Cycling is not adequate for participation in Greenville. However, athletes who already possess a domestic license can be upgrade to an international license. See the USA Cycling website or contact USA Cycling for more information.*

The Greenville SC Para-cycling Open is also part of the U.S. Handcycling Series (USHCS), and athletes who participate – **and are members of U.S. Handcycling** – will receive USHCS points that count towards their national ranking (see <http://www.ushf.org> for more information).

Air/Ground Transportation

- ✓ Athletes are responsible for their own air or ground transportation to and from Greenville, SC. The official event airport is **Greenville Spartanburg International Airport (GSP)**. Flights in to GSP require a connection.
 - Athletes can also fly in to Charlotte Douglas International (CLT), which is ~85 miles away (about 90 minutes by car).
 - Athletes can also fly in to Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport (ATL), which is ~ 150 miles away (about 2.5 hours by car).
