



STUDENT ATHLETE REPRESENTATIVE WANTED

The Southeastern Collegiate Cycling Conference is seeking applications for a male student representative for its board of directors. Applications are being accepted now. The board will submit the slate of nominees to a vote in late October of 2017 with each team receiving one vote. The student will begin their service immediately after the vote. In order to be considered for this role, the student must meet the following criteria:

- The nominee must be a current student and member of a collegiate team in the SECCC,
- The nominee must be in good standing with the conference, their school and their collegiate team, and
- The nominee must have competed in the conference for at least one race season.

HOW TO APPLY

Applications should be sent to the SECCC Board at SECCCBoard@usacycling.org and must be received by October 13th. Please submit a resume and cover letter explaining your background with the conference, why you would like to be a board member and what you would like to accomplish in the role. The board will review the applications and submit them to a vote by the student athletes in the conference. More information on the position can be found below.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE BOARD

Members of the Collegiate Cycling Conference (“SECCC”) Board of Directors serve as appointed volunteers with the responsibility to oversee activities that advance the SECCC’s effectiveness and sustainability. The Board provides oversight to ensure the wise use of all assets of the SECCC. Board members must endeavor to make all decisions in the best interest of the SECCC and to ensure that the SECCC obeys applicable laws and USA Cycling rules and acts in accordance with its mission to advance collegiate cycling throughout the Southeastern Conference.

In carrying out these responsibilities, Board Members specifically perform the following duties:

- Elect a Conference Director responsible for the day-to-day management of conference activities;
- Hire Season Coordinators (who report to the Conference Director) for all necessary cycling disciplines;
- Provide advice and guidance to the Conference Director on decisions involving strategic conference activities, governance, and long-term growth plans;
- Provide conference budget oversight and advice on conference funds allocation;
- Assist with fundraising, messaging and promotional efforts;
- Appoint and supervise a director of the Beginning Racer Program (BRP) and when possible, assist the BRP director in organizing the program events;
- Review and update the SECCC rules as needed in order to maintain compliance with
- USA Cycling rules;
- Communicate with conference clubs, teams and members to show support and maintain healthy relationships between conference leadership and collegiate cyclists; and
- Participate in monthly Board conference calls to discuss conference business.
- Promote collegiate racing for cyclists of all ability levels
