



# TRACK MODULE 2 – CHIEF REFEREE TASKS TO COMPLETE



## Purpose

The purpose of this module is to provide track referees with the necessary information and experience needed for general refereeing responsibilities. The module serves as part of the training necessary for Level C Track Officials for advancement to Level B Track Official.
