All candidates were sent a 2012 Federal Issues Survey by mail and/or Fax and were given ample time to respond. When possible, positions of candidates on issues were verified or determined using voting records, campaign literature or websites and/or public statements.

I encourage you to help spread this important information to others and help make sure they can cast an informed ballot on Election Day.
