SHORT DEFINITIONS

- **Caring** – to put others before yourself
- **Honesty** – to tell the truth

LONG DEFINITIONS

- **Faith** – to develop your relationship with God, to be a seeker of truth, to trust God with your life, to be sure of what you hope for and certain of what you do not see.
