PLEASE NOTE: Unless your vehicle is in the parade, you will NOT be able to turn on to Market Street from West or Hartley Streets after 10am.

PARKING RESTRICTIONS for the YORK SAINT PATRICK'S DAY PARADE (Saturday, March 17, 2018)

9 a.m. (parade staging area)

Parking is prohibited in the parade staging area (400, 500 and 600 blocks of West Market Street) from 9 a.m. until the end of the parade. Violators will be towed. It is critical that we have this area cleared so that our larger parade units may get in place with ample time for assembly and decorating.

Parade participants have been assigned house numbers in this area and it is important that entries are able to park in their assigned locations.

11 a.m. (parade route)

Parking is prohibited on Market Street along the parade route and the block used for disbanding (from Penn to Queen) and on George Street from Philadelphia to King. A few spaces on George Street near Continental Square will also be restricted at 7 a.m. so that parade committee members can unload items.

STREET CLOSINGS

10 a.m.

Market Street from Belvedere to Penn will be closed for parade registration and staging.

11:30 a.m.

Market Street from Beaver to Duke and George Street from Philadelphia to King will be closed for Continental Square entertainment.

Entertainers for Continental Square will be forming in the first block of South George Street.

1 p.m.

Market Street will be closed from Penn to Queen until the parade passes and the street sweeper finishes (estimating the parade will take approximately 1-1/2 hours to pass).

Parade will disband along Market Street in the block between Duke and Queen.

Barricades will be placed at Mason Alley and Clarke Avenue at cross streets so that cars may avoid parade route but still have access through downtown.

All streets should re-open at approximately 4 p.m. after the street sweeper has finished.
