

2014 Stewardship begins at MBIE

- State Sector Act amended to include stewardship (2013)
- Productivity Commission reports on regulatory practices and institutions



Director Regulatory Systems position created

Work begins on defining regulatory systems, developing charters and assessing systems

Regulatory stewardship focus is on the performance of 8 functions within a regulatory system:


- Policy
- Monitoring and evaluation
- Compliance and enforcement
- Delivery
- Operational policy/service design
- Education and information
- Standard setting
- Dispute resolution

First Regulatory Systems Amendment Bill (RSAB) starts




2016 Stewardship gains momentum

Requirement from Treasury to report

Fitness -for-purpose assessments introduced

Reported publicly on MBIE's website



Government Centre for Dispute Resolution (GCDR) established

Stewardship team grows to 3

MBIE's first regulatory stewardship strategy published

RSAB 2 policy work begins

Cabinet direction establishes GCDR to:

- Provide a one-stop shop to support all government dispute resolution regimes
- Reduce inconsistency in approaches and duplication of effort across government dispute resolution systems
- Consolidate knowledge of government dispute resolution
- Plan for the future of government dispute resolution
- Develop dispute resolution best practice principles and guidance
