#### **Audit Key Background**

- AAHomecare created the Audit Key—a free, web-based survey to quantify the impacts of audits and appeals to present compelling data to encourage change.
  - Suppliers use AAHomecare's online survey application, Audit Key (WWW.HMEAuditKey.org), to submit their data with audit and appeal experience.
  - Survey questions are designed to collect *cumulative* audit and appeal experience data going back as far as 10/1/15.

#### **Executive Summary**


- This is the sixth quarter of data which includes audit and appeal information from 10/1/15 through 3/31/17.
- With 6 quarters of data now collected, the survey is gaining momentum.

- With increased confidence levels in the data, the industry will be able to tell a compelling story about the audit and appeal experience of suppliers.






# Medicare (FFS) Prepayment Audit Activity Analysis








