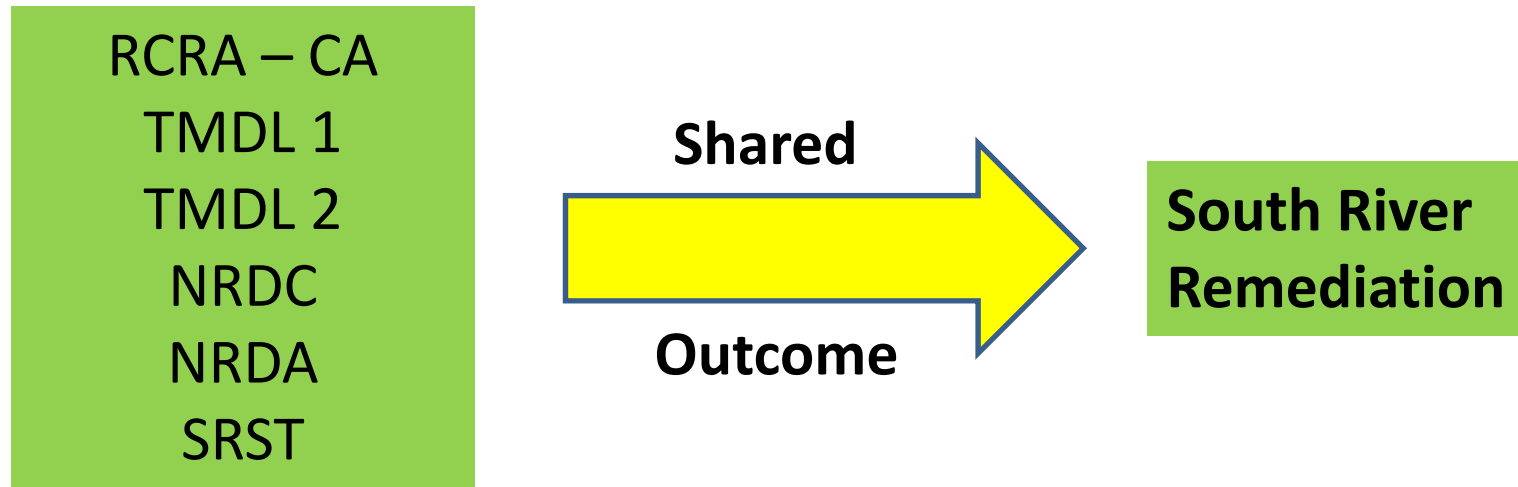

# **“Administrative” Options**

- **Existing RCRA Corrective Action Permit (3008h)**
- **RCRA CA Permit for the off-site mercury component**
- **Consent Order with VA**
- **7003 Order with EPA (Imminent and substantial endangerment)**
- **Superfund Alternative Approach**

# A Decision Has Been Made !!!

- The remediation program for the rivers will be completed under the existing RCRA Corrective Action (CA) permit, modified to include the rivers
- EPA will continue to be the lead agency for on-site (INVISTA plant) CA program until remedy selection is complete, VA DEQ will be the lead agency for on-site implementation
- VA DEQ will be the lead agency for the off-site (rivers) RCRA CA program

# Next Steps

- Assemble and integrate VA DEQ resources
- Permit modification to add the off-site component
- Develop tasks, schedules, deliverables, required approvals to progress towards implementation of the river remediation program
