A Decision Has Been Made !!!

- The remediation program for the rivers will be completed under the existing RCRA Corrective Action (CA) permit, modified to include the rivers
- EPA will continue to be the lead agency for on-site (INVISTA plant) CA program until remedy selection is complete, VA DEQ will be the lead agency for on-site implementation
- VA DEQ will be the lead agency for the off-site (rivers) RCRA CA program

Why is this important?

- SRST is a non-regulatory entity
- The RCRA CA program provides the statutory program
- Defined process
- Opportunity to formally recognize SRST efforts

 - RFI and HH/Eco RA for Off-site
