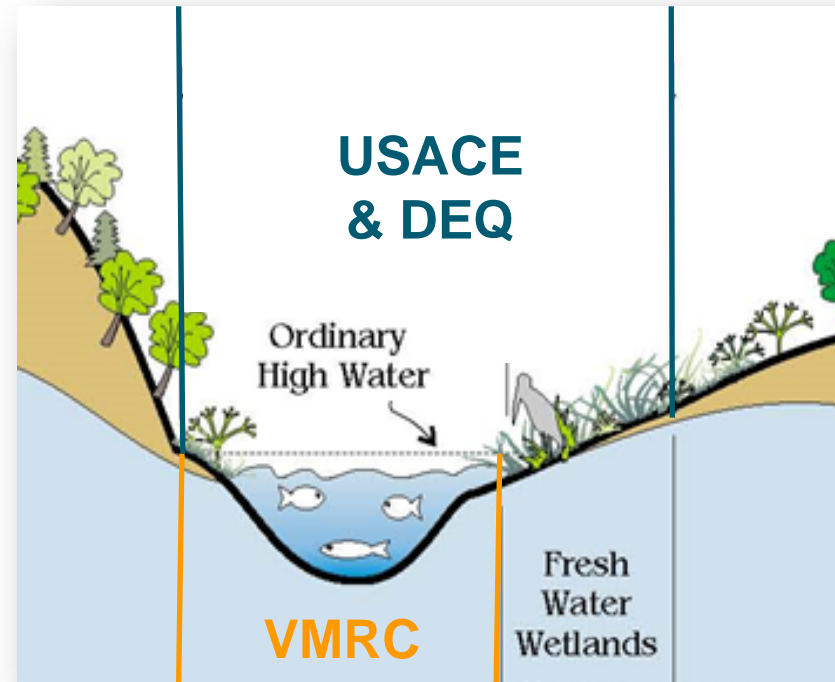

# Regulatory Overview

- No work proposed in wetlands
- Activities below Ordinary High Water (OHW)
  - Permits Required:
    - USACE - Nationwide Permit
    - VMRC - Subaqueous Lands Permit
    - DEQ – Water Quality Certification
  - Joint Permit Application
- Earth Disturbance
  - Land Disturbance Permit / Erosion & Sediment Control Plan



# Pre-Application Coordination

- Pre-Application meeting held November 19, 2016
- Field Meeting conducted on January 5, 2016
- Agencies:
  - USACE
  - VMRC
  - DEQ
- Reviewed design plans and visited BMAs in the field
- Reviewed pilot bank progress



# Agency Feedback

- USACE

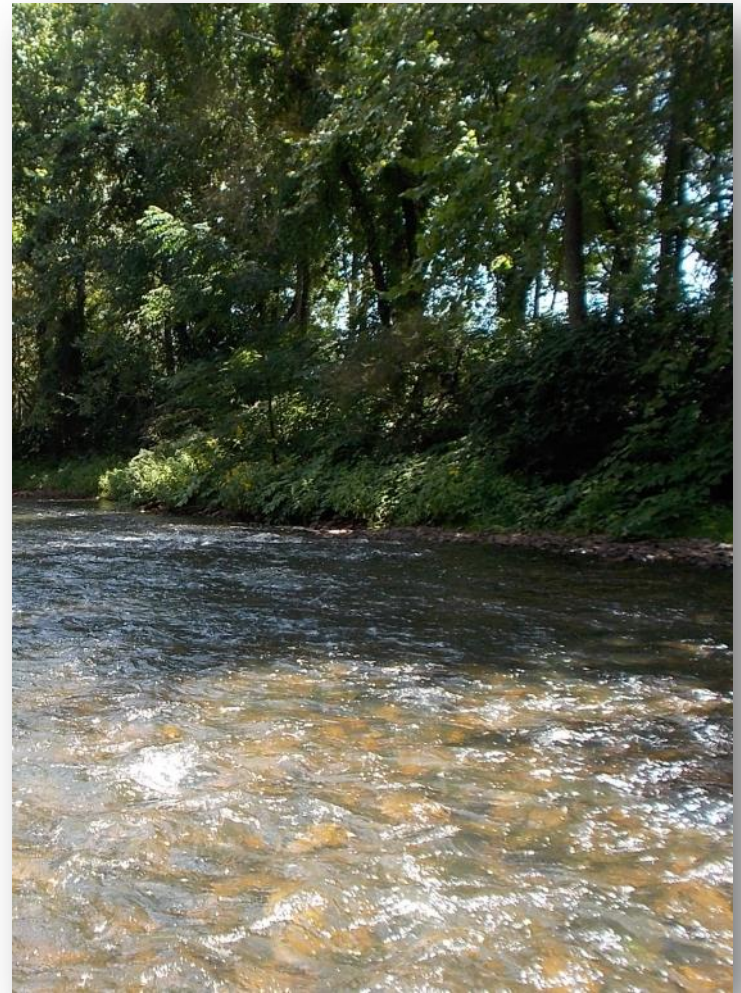
- Nationwide Permit 13 (Bank Stabilization)
- NWP Limits
  - 500 linear feet
  - 1 cubic yard per running foot
  - Limits can be waived by USACE

- VMRC

- Subaqueous Encroachment

- DEQ

- No permit required
- Water quality certification
  - Unconditional for NWP 13



# Permit Application Schedule

- Submit 21 days after completion of design plans
- ~ 60 days for agency review
- Notify USACE 1 week before construction
- Permit Duration
  - NWP
    - All NWPs expire March 2017
    - Request extension in January 2017
  - VMRC
    - Valid for 3 years
    - Can be extended for up to 10 years
- USACE would like to visit BMAs after construction
