Interestingly enough, Mandi doesn't see herself as a productivity expert, but she's found ways to be more productive, and wanted to share that knowledge with an interested audience.

"Alright, this is what people really want. I'll just give it to them. I'll see how it goes. I'm in the process of putting that out to my list and seeing how they want it. At this point, I have enough testers from just people who I've had conversations with in the past that I'm good to test this process. The good thing is is that this finances my product development."

Along with financing her products, the pilot's success also validated the legitimacy of her course. It was a double win!

Instead of spending precious time and money creating a full product and then hoping for interest, she started with the interest and then built a product to match.
