- A. Encouragement sometimes comes in the form of a personal visit.
- B. Encouragement sometimes comes in the form of personal correspondence.
 - a. Correspondence can be inspired by a report that grips our hearts.
 - b. Correspondence can be inspired by the desire to reciprocate affection.
 - c. Correspondence can be inspired by seeing others actively expressing their faith.
 - d. Correspondence can be inspired by seeing God's powerful activity in the lives of those we have fond affection for.
