- A. Encouragement sometimes comes in the form of a personal visit.
- B. Encouragement sometimes comes in the form of personal correspondence.

 - a. Prayers that appeal for God to use us powerfully in the spiritual growth of others.
 - b. Prayers that appeal to God's direct involvement in our lives.
 - c. Prayers that appeal for what we need most from God.
 - i. Increasing our love for others.
 - ii. Increasing our conformity to Jesus.
