Reflection Questions:

- 3. Is there a situation where you are struggling with forgiveness right now? Can you bring that to God and ask for His help to extend the same grace you've been given?
- 4. How does your posture toward forgiveness affect the Harbor community, your family, and other communities you are a part of?

BE STILL

Notice God's presence with you. Breathe in and out. Settle your thoughts.

REFLECT

Replay the day like a movie. Notice what happened.

GIVE THANKS

Look back over the day and thank God for all the blessings He provided today.

CONFESS

Consider and tell God about the parts of your day you need forgiveness for. Consider if there is anyone else you need to ask forgiveness from or extend forgiveness to.

HOPE

Look forward to tomorrow with hope in God's forgiveness and mercy. Ask God for the grace to learn from today's reflection to become more like Him
