- We continue to host a two day event throughout the year in our home called "The Story of God" to help people better understand how the Bible is one beautiful story pointing to Jesus. - We celebrated 9 Years as a church with an amazing cultural potluck displaying all the culture within our church family.
- Our church went to Tijuana, Mexico again in May to build a home for a family through Amor Ministries to help keep families together who couldn't afford to provide for basic needs. We will continue to go every year.
- We kicked off our Summer Meetups this month. MeetUps are fun events around the city that create opportunities for people (young & old) to connect, belong, and be known. We also get to invite others outside of church.
- Our core group of leaders is building up and investing deeply into each other. Vince & Kenny are investing into the elder process to help build a core group of leaders for New City. Trevor is one of the leaders in that eldership process.
 Although nothing is final, he is moving forward in that process as he prays and hopes to discern that move in ministry.
