

## **Exodus**

(ESV)

**John 5:39** You search the Scriptures because you think that in them you have eternal life; and it is they that bear witness about me.

**Luke 24:25-27** And he said to them, "O foolish ones, and slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have spoken! <sup>26</sup> Was it not necessary that the Christ should suffer these things and enter into his glory?" <sup>27</sup> And beginning with Moses and all the Prophets, he interpreted to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning himself.

## **Exodus**

- 1. The Book of Exodus is all about God delivering His people from **SLAVERY IN EGYPT**.
- 2. This historical account is a physical picture of **THE GOSPEL**.

**1 Corinthians 10:1-4, 11** For I do not want you to be unaware, brothers, that our fathers were all under the cloud, and all passed through the sea, <sup>2</sup> and all were baptized into Moses in the cloud and in the sea, <sup>3</sup> and all ate the same spiritual food, <sup>4</sup> and all drank the same spiritual drink. For they drank from the spiritual Rock that followed them, and the Rock was Christ. . <sup>11</sup> Now these things happened to them as an example, but they were written down for our instruction, on whom the end of the ages has come.

## **Exodus Chapter 12**

- 1. God institutes the Feast of **PASSOVER**.
- 2. Passover points directly to **JESUS** in so many ways.

**Exodus 12:1-3, 5-7, 10-12** The LORD said to Moses and Aaron in the land of Egypt,  $^2$ "This month shall be for you the beginning of months. It shall be the first month of the year for you.  $^3$  Tell all the congregation of Israel that on the tenth day of this month every man shall take a lamb according to their fathers' houses, a lamb for a household...  $^5$  Your lamb shall be without blemish, a male a year old. You may take it from the sheep or from the goats,  $^6$  and you shall keep it until the fourteenth day of this month, when the whole assembly of the congregation of Israel shall kill their lambs at twilight.  $^7$  "Then they shall take some of the blood and put it on the two doorposts and the lintel of the houses in which they eat it...

<sup>10</sup> And you shall let none of it remain until the morning; anything that remains until the morning you shall burn <sup>11</sup> It is the LORD's Passover. <sup>12</sup> For I will pass through the land of Egypt that night, and I will strike all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and on all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgments: I am the LORD.

- 3. Passover has even **DEEPER MEANING** more than just holding of **GOD'S JUDGEMENT**, the Hebrew word is **PESACH**.
- 4. Jesus is pictured in the **PESACH**.

## **Other Details**

- 5. Jesus was **EXAMINED BY** the Pharisees, Sadducees, and scribes for **FOUR DAYS**.
- 6. The Passover lamb was **TIED TO THE ALTER** by **9 O'CLOCK** in the morning.
- 7. The Passover lamb was **SLAIN** at **3 O'CLOCK** in the afternoon.
- 8. The Passover meal was **COMPLETE** by **6 O'CLOCK** in the evening.
- 9. When the Priest completed the ritual of **KILLING OF THE LAMB ON THE ALTER** he would lift his hands apart in the air and say **IT IS FINISHED**.

In Exodus, We See Jesus As The Passover Lamb And The Pesach Through, Which Salvation And Transformation Are Given!
