Luke 23:35-43 And the people stood by, watching, but the rulers scoffed at him, saying, "He saved others; let him save himself, if he is the Christ of God, his Chosen One!" ³⁶ The soldiers also mocked him, coming up and offering him sour wine ³⁷ and saying, "If you are the King of the Jews, save yourself!" ³⁸ There was also an inscription over him, "This is the King of the Jews." ³⁹ One of the criminals who were hanged railed at him, saying, "Are you not the Christ? Save yourself and us!" ⁴⁰ But the other rebuked him, saying, "Do you not fear God, since you are under the same sentence of condemnation? ⁴¹ And we indeed justly, for we are receiving the due reward of our deeds; but this man has done nothing wrong." ⁴² And he said, "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom." ⁴³ And he said to him, "Truly, I say to you, today you will be with me in paradise."

The Cross Of Christ Reveals Excruciating Pain And Excruciating Love!

Jesus' Endurance Of The Mockers Displays His Incredible Love.

1. He faced the mocking **LEADERS**!

<u>Luke 23:35</u> And the people stood by, watching, but the rulers scoffed at him, saying, "He saved others; let him save himself, if he is the Christ of God, his Chosen One!"

2. He faced the mocking **SOLDIERS**!

Luke 23:36-38 The soldiers also mocked him, coming up and offering him sour wine ³⁷ and saying, "If you are the King of the Jews, save yourself!" ³⁸ There was also an inscription over him, "This is the King of the Jews."

3. He faced the mocking **DEMONS OF HELL!**

<u>Luke 22:3-4</u> Then Satan entered into Judas called Iscariot, who was of the number of the twelve. ⁴ He went away and conferred with the chief priests and officers how he might betray him to them.

<u>1 Corinthians 2:7-8</u> But we impart a secret and hidden wisdom of God, which God decreed before the ages for our glory. ⁸ None of the rulers of this age understood this, for if they had, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory.

<u>Matthew 4:8-9</u> Again, the devil took him to a very high mountain and showed him all the kingdoms of the world and their glory. ⁹And he said to him, "All these I will give you, if you will fall down and worship me."

4. He faced the mocking **THIEVES**!

Mark 15:32 ... Those who were crucified with him also reviled him.

He was mocked by the <u>HARDEN CRIMINAL</u>!

Luke 23:39 One of the criminals who were hanged railed at him, saying, "Are you not the Christ? Save yourself and us!"

He was embraced by the <u>REPENTANT CRIMINAL</u>!

Jesus' Saves!

1. Jesus' encounter with the repentant thief demonstrates without doubt salvation comes through $\underline{\textbf{JESUS}}!$

<u>Luke 23:43</u> And he said to him, "Truly, I say to you, today you will be with me in paradise."
