IMPACT GROUP QUESTIONS

KEY PASSAGE: JOHN 13:36-14:7

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage? *Prepare to follow Jesus into Heaven, a privilege saved for later; Don't worry about eternity. Trust Jesus to have it all in hand; Abide in the One who is the way, the truth, and the life.*

INFORM THE HEAD / STIR THE HEART

1. What conclusions can you draw about the heart of Jesus from when He told Peter He knew Peter would deny Him three times?

2. What perspective can knowing that Jesus is preparing a place for us give you in your present circumstances?

3. From the message, please list the three reasons we stumble when following Jesus. Of the three, which one do you find trips you up the most as you seek to follow Him?

4. Please explain the significance of Jesus being the way, the truth, and the life. How would the opposite meaning of each impact your life?

5. What other ways and truths does the world give for receiving eternal life?

6. What is significant about Jesus’ words, “No one comes to the FATHER but by Me” rather than if He said, “No one goes to HEAVEN but by Me”?

7. How is knowing and seeing Jesus the same as knowing and seeing the Father? Why is that important?

Based on what you learned in Sunday’s message and in your study time, what is one measurable thing you will go after this week in your walk with Christ?
