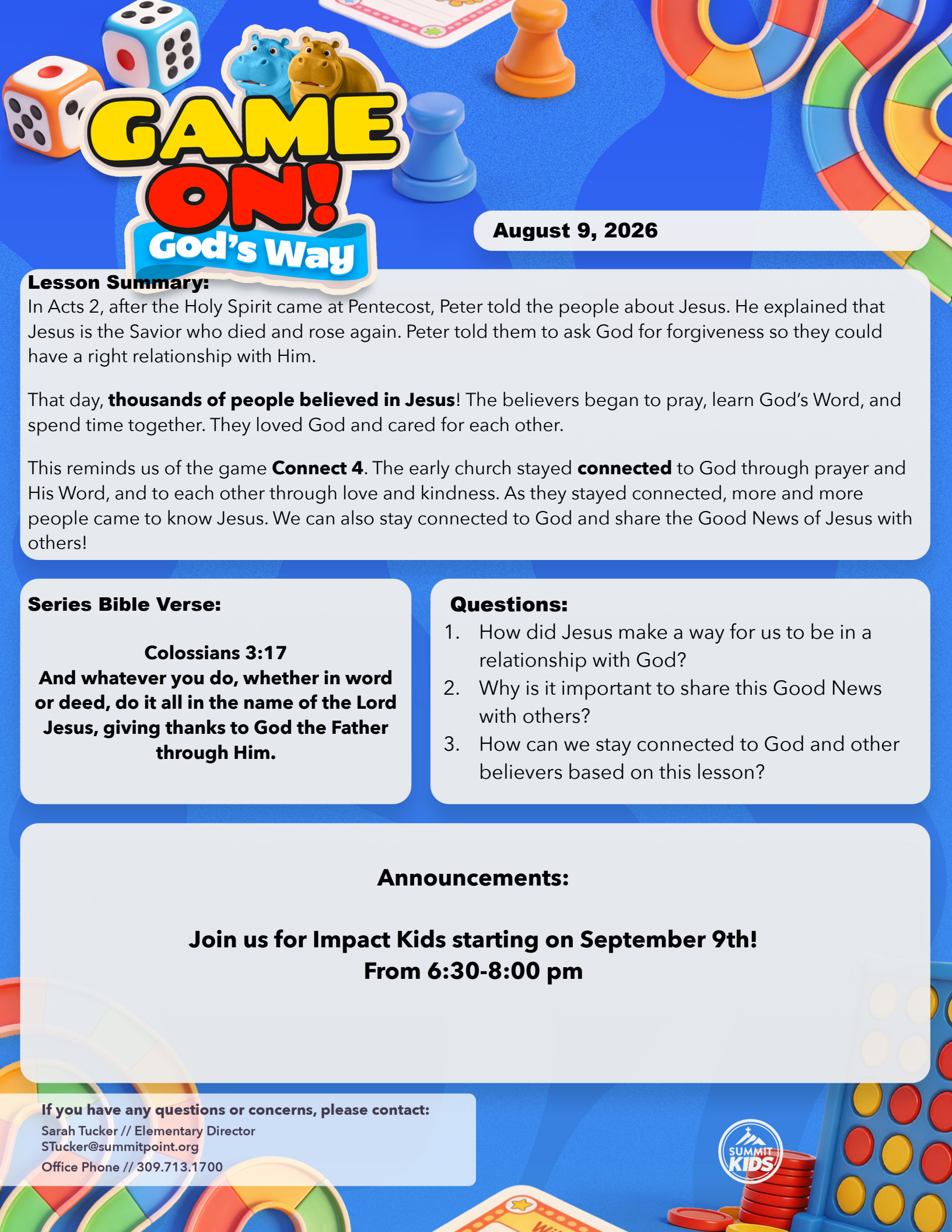




GAME ON!

Lesson Summary:

In Acts 2, after the Holy Spirit came at Pentecost, Peter told the people about Jesus. He explained that Jesus is the Savior who died and rose again. Peter told them to ask God for forgiveness so they could have a right relationship with Him.

That day, **thousands of people believed in Jesus!** The believers began to pray, learn God's Word, and spend time together. They loved God and cared for each other.

This reminds us of the game **Connect 4**. The early church stayed **connected** to God through prayer and His Word, and to each other through love and kindness. As they stayed connected, more and more people came to know Jesus. We can also stay connected to God and share the Good News of Jesus with others!
