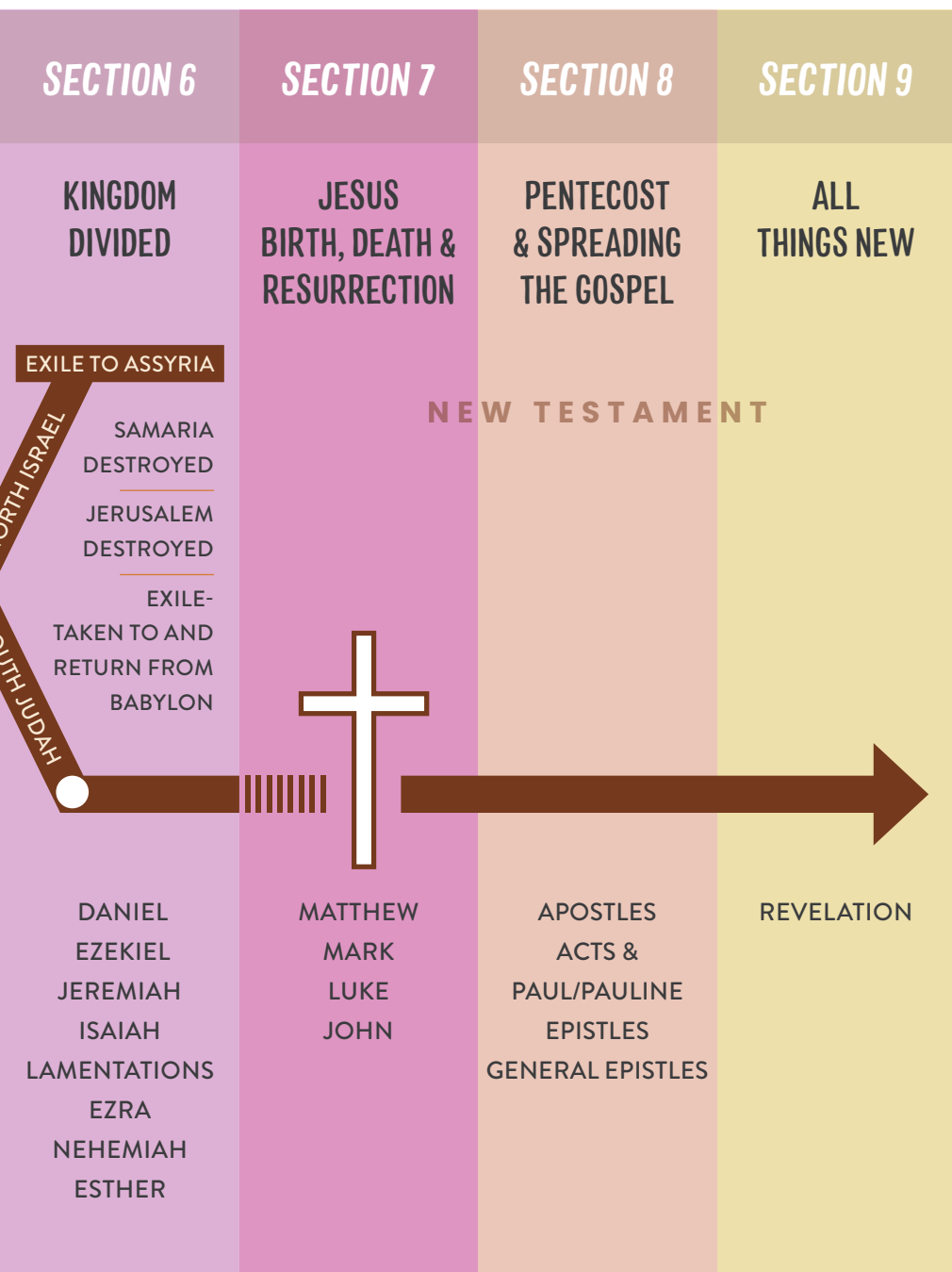

Esther 4:14b- “And who knows but that you have come to your royal position for such a time as this?”

THE STORY SO FAR:

Esther was the queen of Persia. God had placed her in a very important position, even though she didn't know why yet. Mordecai found out about a plan to destroy God's people, the Jews. He was very upset and told Esther. When Esther learned what was happening, Mordecai asked her to go to the king and ask for help. This was scary because no one could go to the king without being invited. Esther could even be put to death! But Mordecai reminded her that she might have been **chosen** to be queen for this exact moment.



Esther asked all the people to fast and pray for her. Then she bravely went to see the king, ready to do what was right, even if it was dangerous. Even though God's name isn't mentioned, we can see that He was working the whole time. God had a plan, and Esther was **chosen** to be part of it. Just like Esther, you are **chosen by God** and placed where you are for a special purpose.

THE STORY SO FAR:

In Psalm 139:13–18, King David praises God because he knows God made him on purpose. God created David before he was even born and knew all the days of his life. David understood that God loved him and cared for him all the time—when he was awake and even when he was sleeping.



This brought David comfort and joy because he knew he was not an accident—he was **chosen by God** and had a purpose. Just like David, **you are chosen by God**. He knows you, loves you, and has a special plan for your life.

Ruth 1:16b- “Your people will be my people and your God my God.”

THE STORY SO FAR:

In the book of Ruth, we see God’s love and hope. Ruth lived during the time of the Judges, when many people were not following God. In Ruth 1, Ruth went through a very sad time when her husband died. Even though life was hard, Ruth chose to stay with her mother-in-law, Naomi, and follow Naomi’s God—the one true God. Ruth was not from God’s people, but she chose to trust Him and be part of His family.

Like a journey, Ruth kept trusting God as she moved to a new land with Naomi. Their life was difficult at first, but God was guiding them the whole way. Even though Ruth was an outsider, **God chose Ruth to be part of His plan.** He brought her into His family and used her life in a special way. This shows us that **God can choose anyone**, and He has a purpose for every person who follows Him.

Ruth 4:14a- The women said to Naomi: “Praise be to the Lord, who this day has not left you without a guardian-redeemer.”

THE STORY SO FAR:

In Ruth 4, God showed His kindness by bringing Ruth and Boaz together. Boaz became Ruth’s **guardian-redeemer**, which means he took care of her and helped rescue her family. They were married and had a son named Obed. Obed later became the grandfather of King David.

God turned their sadness into joy and hope. The Bible reminds us in Romans 5:5 that God's love fills us with hope. Ruth was not originally part of God's people, but God chose Ruth to be part of His family and His plan. He used her life in a very special way. Boaz reminds us of Jesus. Just like Boaz was a redeemer for Ruth, **Jesus is our Redeemer**. He rescues us and brings us into God's family. Just like Ruth, **we are chosen by God**. We can trust Him, follow Him, and know that His love for us never changes.

1 Samuel 1:27- “I prayed for this child, and the Lord has granted me what I asked of him.”

THE STORY SO FAR:

In 1 Samuel 1, Hannah loved the Lord very much. She was very sad because she wanted to be a mother, but she could not have a child. Instead of becoming angry or bitter, Hannah prayed and poured her heart out to God. While worshipping at the tabernacle, Hannah asked God for a son and promised that she would give him back to the Lord. She trusted God and put her hope in Him.

God heard Hannah's prayers and blessed her with a son named Samuel. Samuel would grow up to be a very special leader—the last judge of Israel. Hannah kept her promise and gave Samuel back to serve the Lord, because she knew he belonged to God. **God chose Samuel for a special purpose**, even before he was born. And just like Samuel, **we are chosen by God**. He hears our prayers, has a plan for our lives, and uses us for His glory.

1 Samuel 3:19- The Lord was with Samuel as he grew up, and he let none of Samuel's words fall to the ground.

THE STORY SO FAR:

In 1 Samuel 3, God had not been speaking much to His people because they were choosing to ignore Him. But God, in His faithfulness, called a young boy named Samuel.

Samuel had been dedicated to serving the Lord by his mother, Hannah. One night, God called Samuel, and Samuel listened. He was ready to obey God, even when it was hard. God gave Samuel an important message to share. While others were not following God, **Samuel was chosen to listen and obey.** God was with Samuel as he grew up, and everyone could see that **God had chosen him** to be a leader and speak His truth to Israel. Just like Samuel, we are chosen by God. We can listen to Him, trust Him, and follow Him.

1 Samuel 8:7- And the Lord told him:” Listen to all the people are saying to you; it is not you they have rejected, but they have rejected me as their king.”

THE STORY SO FAR:

In 1 Samuel 8, Samuel made his sons leaders over Israel, but they did not follow God. So the people came to Samuel and asked for a king to lead them. They wanted to be like the other nations. But by asking for an earthly king, they were rejecting God as their true King.

Samuel warned them that a king would take from them and make them serve him. But the people would not listen. They chose what they wanted instead of trusting God. **The people chose an earthly king instead of God, the forever King.**

This reminds us that we all have a choice. We can follow our own way, or we can follow God. **God has chosen us to be part of His kingdom,** and He wants us to trust Him as our true King.

1 Samuel 9:17- When Samuel caught sight of Saul, the Lord said to him, “This is the man I have spoken to you about; he will govern my people.”

THE STORY SO FAR:

At the beginning of 1 Samuel 9, Saul is introduced. He looked like a king—he was tall and handsome. God had heard His people asking for a king, and He told Samuel that He would send a man from the tribe of Benjamin to be their leader.

God chose Saul and told Samuel to anoint him as king. Samuel met Saul, spent time with him, and anointed him with oil to show that he was the **chosen king of Israel**. God had a plan to use Saul to lead His people and help rescue them from their enemies. Even though Saul looked like the right choice on the outside, we learn that what matters most is not how someone looks, but that they are **chosen by God and follow Him**.

1 Samuel 15:26- But Samuel said to Saul, “I will not go back with you. You have rejected the word of the Lord, and the Lord has rejected you as king over Israel!”

THE STORY SO FAR:

In 1 Samuel 15, God gave Saul a clear command through Samuel. Saul was told to completely destroy the Amalekites and everything that belonged to them. Saul and his army attacked, but Saul did not fully obey God. He kept the king and the best animals instead of doing what God had said. Then Saul told Samuel that he had obeyed, but that was not true.

Samuel told Saul that because he had disobeyed God, the kingdom would be taken away from him. Saul tried to say sorry, but his heart had not truly followed God. Saul had been **chosen by God to be king**, but he chose not to obey. Because of this, God would **choose another king**.

ALL IS FOUND VERSE:

1 Samuel 16:7b- The Lord does not look at the things people look at. People look at the outward appearance, but the Lord looks at the heart.

THE STORY SO FAR:

In 1 Samuel 16, God told Samuel to anoint a new king to replace Saul, because Saul had disobeyed Him. When Samuel saw David's older brothers, they looked strong and important. But God told Samuel not to look at outward appearance. **God looks at the heart.**

David was out taking care of his father's sheep when Samuel came. He may not have looked like a king, but **God chose David** because of what was in his heart. Samuel anointed David, showing that he was the **chosen future king of Israel**. This reminds us that God doesn't choose people based on how they look on the outside. **God has chosen us**, and we can follow Him with our whole heart.

1 Samuel 17:47- “All those gathered here will know that it is not by the sword or spear that the Lord saves, for the battle is the Lord’s and he will give all of you into our hands”.

THE STORY SO FAR:

In 1 Samuel 17, Israel was at war with the Philistines. David went to the camp to bring food to his brothers. While he was there, he saw Goliath, a giant who was making fun of God and the Israelite army. The soldiers were afraid, but David was not. He knew how powerful God is and trusted Him completely.

Even though David was young, **God had chosen him**, and David believed that God would help him. So David went out to fight Goliath not in his own strength, but in God's power. With just a sling and a stone, David defeated Goliath. God gave him the victory.

This reminds us that **when we are chosen by God, we can trust Him**. He is always with us and gives us the strength we need.

1 Samuel 20:42a- Jonathan said to David, “Go in peace, for we have sworn friendship with each other in the name of the Lord.”

THE STORY SO FAR:

In 1 Samuel 20, David had done nothing wrong, but King Saul was trying to hurt him. David had to run away to stay safe. Jonathan, Saul's son, was in a very hard situation. He loved his father, but he was also a good friend to David. At first, Jonathan didn't believe his father wanted to harm David, so he and David made a plan to find out the truth. After the test, Jonathan saw that Saul really did want to hurt David. This made Jonathan very sad and upset. Even though Saul wanted his own family to be king, Jonathan knew that **God had chosen David** to be the next king.

Jonathan warned David so he could escape. Then David and Jonathan made a promise to always care for each other and their families. David and Jonathan showed what a true, godly friendship looks like. They trusted God and supported each other. This reminds us that **God chooses leaders for His plan**, and He also gives us friends to help us follow Him.

1 Samuel 24:18- “You have just now told me about the good you did to me; the Lord delivered me into your hands, but you did not kill me.”

THE STORY SO FAR:

In Psalm 54, David prayed and asked God to show Saul that he was not his enemy. In 1 Samuel 24, God answered that prayer. David and his men were hiding in a cave when Saul came into that same cave. David had a chance to hurt Saul, but he chose not to. Instead, he showed mercy.

David only cut off a small piece of Saul's robe to prove that he did not want to harm him. After Saul left the cave, David called out to him and showed him the piece of the robe. This showed Saul that David was not trying to hurt him, even when he had the chance. Saul realized that David would be the next king.

David showed what a godly leader looks like. He trusted God and chose mercy instead of revenge. **David was chosen to be the next king, and he chose to do what was right.** Because God has shown us mercy, even when we didn't deserve it, we can choose to show mercy to others.
