

DISCOVERING Jesus

Passage Luke 8:40-56

Main Point Jesus is powerful to heal.

Application I can trust Jesus.

Bible Summary

Last week, we learned about a time when Jesus calmed a storm by the power of His words. Today, as we continue to learn and discover more about Jesus, we learn about a time when Jesus had come back to His hometown and was welcomed by a crowd of people. Among the people was a man named Jairus, who had a very sick daughter, and a woman who had been sick for twelve years. Both of these people went to Jesus to help them. The man fell at Jesus' feet and pleaded with Him to help his daughter. The woman believed, if she would only touch Jesus, He could heal her. As Jesus was walking through the crowd of people, He felt someone touch Him. He asked who had touched Him and the woman fell at His feet. She told Him why she had touched Him and said He had immediately healed her. Jesus told her that her faith had healed her, but while He was speaking, another man told Jairus his daughter had died. When Jesus heard this, He told Jairus not to be afraid, but instead, to believe and his daughter would be healed. When Jesus came to Jairus' home, He only let Jairus, his wife, and three of His disciples come into the house. The crowd of people outside were upset the child had died, but Jesus told them she was only asleep. When He saw the child in her bed, He took the girl's hand and told her to get up. Her parents were amazed when they saw that she was healed. Jesus is powerful. He was able to heal the sick woman and the sick daughter and He is able to heal us too. We all need to be healed from our sin and Jesus is able to do that, when we put our trust in Him.

Digging Deeper

Jesus wants us to know about Him and His power, but at the end of this story, He told Jairus and his wife not to tell anyone about how He healed their daughter. He knew many of the religious leaders were upset with Him and they were already planning to kill Him. Jesus wasn't finished with His ministry on earth though and He didn't want the religious leaders to create anymore issues or distractions.
