Passage Matthew 5:14-16

Main Point Jesus is the light of the world.

Application I can be a light for Jesus.

Bible Summary

Have you ever gone outside at night and looked at the stars? A lot of people like to get away from the city lights to look at the stars in the evening. If you are able to drive far enough north though, you can sometimes look at something else in the night sky called the Northern Lights. To see these lights, you not only need to go north, but you also need to get away from the city lights, because lights show up best in the dark. One day, when Jesus was teaching, He said believers are the light of the world. We live in a dark and broken world, full of sin and sickness, but this world is not our forever home. Jesus is the light of the world and He has a perfect forever home for us where there will be no more sin or sickness. As believers in this dark and broken world, we can share with others the Good News of Jesus and the hope we can have in Him. Not only can we tell others about Jesus, but we can also show them Jesus by living for Him rather than living for things the world and others try to tell us are true, good, and important. Satan is good at using things of the world to try and trick us, but we can be like a light shining in a dark room or like Northern lights dancing across a dark sky when we live for Jesus and tell others about Him.

Look at the stars in town before you look at the stars outside of town. How many more stars can you see away from the city lights? How can you and your family be a light for Jesus in this dark world?
