DIGGING DEEPER

While in the car, ask your child what Bible story they learned at church this week. Encourage them to teach the story to you and helping them as needed.



Look at your child's Take Home sheet and read the lesson summary before dinner. At dinner, give your child clues about a Bible character from the lesson and encourage them to guess the Bible character and then talk about the story. You could also give clues about other Bible stories and encourage children to guess the story.



As you are helping your child get ready for bed, ask them how they saw Jesus during the day. Did He help them try something new at the park? Did He help them make a new friend? Did He help them to share a toy?



Write the series Bible verse in a place you will see it everyday and challenge everyone in your family to memorize it by the end of summer.
