Trail Stop Recap ::::::::

After the flood, the earth began to fill with people again. Everyone spoke the same language and lived close together. The people decided to build a huge tower to reach heaven and make a name for themselves. But God was not pleased. He had not created people to make their own name great, but to make His name great and known to all.

God saw their plan and gave them a different one. He came down and confused their language so they could no longer understand each other. The place was called Babel because it sounded like the people were babbling. Since they could not understand one another, they stopped building the tower. God then scattered the people across the earth, creating many nations.

Many years later, Jesus told His disciples to share the Gospel with all nations. God made us to worship Him and to tell others how great He is. One day, people from every nation who trust in Jesus will live with Him together in His perfect home.

Continuing on the Trail at Home

Challenge your child to build a really tall tower with legos or blocks while talking about this story. As they are building, help them by giving helpful tips to prevent the tower from falling. Once the tower gets fairly tall, begin to babblel in a way your child cannot understand. Are they confused? What might it have been like for the people building the tower of Babel. Why did they want to build a tower? Why did God create us? Who can you share God's greatness with? What can you tell them about God's greatness?
