## Trail Stop Recap :::::::

God had promised Abraham that He would grow a great nation from his family. That nation was the Israelites, who had been living as slaves in Egypt. Now it was time for God to bring them out of Egypt and into the land He had promised Abraham many years earlier.

God called Moses to lead the Israelites out, and He sent many signs and wonders in the form of plagues to show His power and authority. Pharaoh did not want to let the Israelites go because he would lose all his workers. But God promised to bring His people out of Egypt, and after the tenth plague, Pharaoh finally told the Israelites to leave.

Moses and the Israelites quickly left, but Pharaoh changed his mind again and chased after them with his army. Yet God is greater than any army and provides for all our needs. He showed His power once more by parting the Red Sea, allowing the Israelites to walk through on dry ground.

Before God led them out, the Israelites were stuck in Egypt. In the same way, we are stuck in our sin with no way to save ourselves. But just as God made a way for the Israelites, He has made a way for us to be saved—through Jesus.
